I (we) agree that the Northern Alberta Canine Association has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association and associated Specialty Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

NOTICE TO U.S. EXHIBITORS RE: ERN NUMBERS

Dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$62.40 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES BY U.S. EXHIBITORS: Current exchange rate favors the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they must be payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds, or 'at par' as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated!

BORDER CROSSING: A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this certificate and it MUST be updated at least thirty days prior to re-entry into the U.S.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's email address.
2. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.
3. Exhibitors are to pick up after their dogs both inside and outside of the show building; any exhibitor not doing so will be removed from the show.
4. No dogs are allowed to run loose any time

CLASSIFICATION

Regular/Non-Regular Classes – Saturday, June 4th - Judge: Mr. Terry Stacy

REGULAR CLASSES

The following Regular classes will be divided by sex:

JUNIOR PUPPY – dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show

SENIOR PUPPY – dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show

12-18 MONTHS – dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show

CANADIAN BRED – dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs

VETERAN CLASS – for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in the Veteran Class **may be spayed/neutered.**

SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female:

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

(Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only)

BABY PUPPY - 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

Winners of this class do not compete for points. Baby puppy will be divided by sex

Winners male and Winners female will compete for Best Baby Puppy in Specialty.

EXHIBITION ONLY: Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

EXHIBITION ONLY 3-6 months – catalogue listing only.

SIRE & GET: for a stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

DAM & PROGENY: for a dam and 2 or more of her progeny. Same rules as Sire & Get.

BRACE: for 2 dogs of the same breed, not necessarily of the same sex and not necessarily by the same owner. Judged as an identical pair – same color, size, gait, and same stride. Must be handled by one person on one lead.

STRIP DOWN: Shall be offered for any CKC registered American Cocker Spaniel of any age over 6 months (including neutered or spayed dogs). Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum length of 1 ½ inches long on any portion of the body, with the exception of the ears where no length restrictions apply. Entrants are to be judged on conformation. All males will be judged first as one class, and then all bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of these two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Down. Entrants must be entered in a Regular Class in the Specialty, Obedience Trial or Agility, or Exhibition Only to compete in the Stripped Down.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

As per CKC rules, all dogs entered in these Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at this Specialty Show held on June 4, 2016. Classes will be divided males and females in the following age categories:

3-6 MONTHS 6-9 MONTHS 9-12 MONTHS 12-18 MONTHS

The winners of all eight classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

The club will retain 10% of total entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be distributed as follows:
