"The participation in any manner or in any capacity at a competitive event held under these Rules shall be considered a privilege accorded to any person by the CKC and such privilege may be extended and withdrawn by the Discipline Committee". "Any person availing himself of the privilege of participating in any manner, shape or form and in any capacity, including that of a spectator at a competitive event held under these rules shall, by such participation, be deemed to have agreed to the authority of the CKC and its Board of Directors."

"A judge officiating at a dog show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."

 ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trials) is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

The LKOC will not tolerate verbal abuse of officials, members or volunteers at this show and offenders may be dismissed from the show without refund.
