ENTRIES: Entries are to be submitted online through www.dogshow.ca

Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can run during daylight hours and a waitlist will be established as tests fill. Please ensure to indicate on your entry if you wish to be added to the waitlist.

*** Temporary Competition Fee (TCN Number):** CKC TCN Fee of \$10.50 per dog, per test is payable with the entry fee if the entry form for the dog does not include the CKC Individual Registration Number. Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is individually registered.

All entries are to be completed and entry fees paid in full BY THE CLOSING DATE. Fees for entries withdrawn after the closing time will not be refunded.

Entries will be accepted starting Thursday, August 15th, 2024 at 7 P.M. Pacific Daylight Time

Day of test entries will be accepted if the schedule and bird numbers allow. Such entries must be presented to the Test Secretary no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start time for that test along with an additional fee of \$10.00.

**Entries Close at 7 PM Wednesday, August 28th, 2024 or earlier if limit is reached.
The DRAW will be immediately after closing August 28th at the Test Secretary's home.**

LIABILITY: All entries for these Field Dog Tests are accepted on condition that Vizsla Canada, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of these tests. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of their parent or guardian.

Test Information:

- **COURSES & BIRDS:** Chukar, quail, pheasant and/or pigeons will be released. The tests will be run on a single course. Depending on course conditions, the Test Committee may adjust the course, including the addition of a bird field, to suit. All dogs with bird work will be shot over with blank cartridges on game contact.
- **HORSES or QUADS:** May be used by judges & bird planters. There will be no horses or motorized vehicles allowed in the gallery.
- **BLAZE ORANGE** coat or vest & hat are recommended apparel for all participants & spectators when on the course.
- **STARTER PISTOLS** are required at all levels of the Field Dog Tests. Please provide your own or arrange to borrow one before you take your dog to the start line.

- **GALLERY:** A gallery of spectators may be permitted to follow the test dogs. This will be at the sole discretion of the judge and handler. Spectators must stay together at all times & shall follow the directions of the judges & marshal.
- **ENTRIES are limited** to the number of dogs that can be run in approximately 8 hours judging time.
- **The schedule may be adjusted** if the daytime temperatures are extreme. There will be water on the course but bring containers to **carry water** for yourself and your dog.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** will be allowed to run at the end of the day. After bitches in season have been run, no other dogs will be run on the course until the next day.
- **COLLARING only with permission of the Judge.** This applies to ALL test levels.
- **TRACKING COLLARS** will be permitted. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. A dog that is located using a tracking collar during its run is no longer under judgement.
- **EXERCISING OR TRAINING** of any dogs on the grounds before, during or after the test is completed is prohibited without the permission of the Field Test Chairman or Field Test Secretary.
- **NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME PERMITTED ANYWHERE ON THESE GROUNDS. THIS AREA IS EXTREMELY DRY AND VULNERABLE TO THE SMALLEST SPARK. PLEASE RESPECT THE LANDOWNERS' WISH AND ABIDE BY THIS RULE OR YOU MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE.**
- All participants must be familiar with the **CKC Rules** and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. **New CKC 2023 Field Dog & Water Tests** rulebooks are available from the CKC or online at the CKC website.

NOTE: Access to these grounds has been granted on a one-time basis for the test weekend. Anyone failing to respect this will be banned from future events.

CAMPING: Self-contained units or tents are permitted on the site. **The fee is \$10 per night.** Dry camping only as there are no hookups, potable water, or power. You are encouraged to bring your own generator and sufficient water for yourself and your dogs. A port-a-potti will be provided on-site. Please pack out all your garbage and leave no trace! **Please contact bcallbreedpointerclub@gmail.com to reserve.**

Heat could be a concern. You will want to provide shade for yourself and your dogs.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **BORDER CROSSING:** A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and the USA. Government regulations require a valid Rabies Certificate dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Note that border crossings now involve more thorough inspection of vehicles, dogs and papers. Proof of citizenship is required for entry into Canada and return to the USA. Please carry proof of citizenship. At the test, **we can arrange for you to borrow a starter pistol** as it can be a problem to bring one across the border.

Directions to Jura Stock Ranch:

Princeton/Summerland Road, Princeton, BC

Take Highway #3 into Princeton (from either east or west) and turn towards town onto Bridge Street (Petro-Canada station on the corner). Immediately turn right onto Highway #5A. Take Highway #5A over the steel bridge and just around the curve up the hill, turn right on Old Hedley Road.

If coming across the US border in western Washington, take the Sumas/Huntington crossing. This crossing will take you directly to Highway #1 eastbound. Once you get to Hope (about 1 to 1 1/2 hours) you will see the sign for Highway #3 which goes off to the right.

If you are coming into Princeton from Highway #5A north (Merritt, etc.) stay on it until there is a turn to the left just as you come over the hill into town (a marker is the road sign warning of a change to speed of 70 km/hr.). Turn left onto Old Hedley Road.

From Old Hedley Road, quite quickly you will turn left onto the Princeton/Summerland Road (also known as Osprey Lake Road). Drive past the fair grounds and stay on that same road for approximately 7 km. You will pass Belfort Road on your left and then the road bends to the right. You will see a sign on your right for Jura Stock Ranch/Maverick Saloon. Turn right into the driveway and you are there!
