A \$11.30 fee must accompany any entry form of dogs for which an individual CKC registration or ERN number is not shown. A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) may be obtained by contacting the CKC. Separate entry forms must be completed for each stake the dog is entered. Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date for reasons other than stated in the CKC Retriever Field Trial rule book will not have their entry fees refunded. Canadian residents who are non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot be awarded a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or membership fee to the CKC.

PLEASE NOTE A temporary competition fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

**Running Order:** We will utilize the 2 ending digits in the TSX as of the close of business on Wednesday, May 7, 2025 as a starting number for the first series in the all age stakes. Judges will impose a system of rotation thereafter in the All Age stakes. Dogs will run in order of the draw with sexes mixed. There may be rotation in the minor stakes.
