DO YOU HAVE HAVE A MIXED BREED OR A BREED NOT RECOGNIZED BY THE CKC?

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds.

CANINE COMPANION NUMBER

For a Mixed or All Canadian Bred Dog

All dogs that are mixed must have a Canine Companion Number CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized-breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

For a foreign-owned, registered dog

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

AN ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT TO AVOID CANCELLATION OF AWARDS.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

Required for an un-registerable purebred dog

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an un-registerable dog of a CKC recognized of listed breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. A PEN dog must meet the following criteria: be of a CKC recognized or listed breed; for one rea- son or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration; and must be spayed or neutered.

All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched.
- No Flexi-leads, or prong or electronic collars allowed.
- A \$10 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last course.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- There shall be two course lengths, 300 and 600 yards (273 and 545 meters).
 - o The short course shall be for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic (flat-faced dogs).
 - The long course shall be used by all dogs not eligible to run the short distance.
 - If there is a question on which course a dog shall run the judge shall decide.

COMPETING DOGS

- Dogs must complete the entire distance of their course with enthusiasm and without interruption.
- Dogs shall run as singles ONLY.
- The dog may wear a catch collar that is free of any item which may become entangled in the line, the collar shall be snug to minimize the chance of getting caught in the line

EXHIBITION ONLY DOGS

 Dogs entered as exhibition only will run once at the end of each Event, they will not be judged or receive a title or ribbon.


EQUIPMENT:

TITLES

- Chase Ability (CA) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges
- Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)
- Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability Event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)
