

Take Hwy 1 North to Nanaimo Airport, turn right onto Spitfire Rd. *** enter the round-a-bout and exit at the 3rd road.



 $\underline{\textit{Veterans Stake}}$:. Hounds designated as veterans on entry form and entered in OPEN will be eligible for an additional prize

SINGLES STAKE: Open to all sight hounds over the age of 1 year not entered in the trial. Will run individually, twice, after the official runs. Runs will be judged but no points will be awarded. Ties will be decided by a coin toss. Limited to 10 hounds.

PUPPY FUN RUN Saturday: For puppies whose age on the day of the trial is six months, but less than 18 months and who are not entered in the trial. Puppies will run once individually on a shortened course and be scored. Placements of first through NBQ may be awarded but will not count for points. This stake may be divided by age. **OLD TIMERS FUN RUN Sunday:** For any hound seven years of age or older the day of the trial and not entered in the trial. Old Timers will be run once individually on a shortened course and will be scored. Handicap of 2 pts will be added for each year over seven. (8 years = judges score + 2 pts)

KENNEL STAKE Sunday: For any 2 hounds entered in open stake owned by and living with the same owner. Total scores to determine the winner.

BREEDER STAKE Sunday: For any 2 hounds entered in open stake bred by the same person. Total scores to determine the winner.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."
