Parking, Loading/Unloading, Benching and Building Hours

- Building opening/closing times
 - o Thursday Open no earlier than 3:00pm, closes at 11pm SHARP.
 - o Friday and Saturday Open 6 am sharp, closes at 10 pm SHARP.
 - Sunday Open at 6am SHARP, Closes 2 hours after the completion of ALL events
- Unloading/Loading (see map)
 - The venue will not be open to exhibitors ANY EARLIER THAN 3:00 PM on Thursday, November 18.
 - All vehicles that need to unload/load <u>must enter/exit through the Access Gate</u> on the East side of the Agri-food & Trade building. This is a manned gate and only 10 vehicles are permitted within the enclosure so PLEASE UNLOAD/LOAD AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE to avoid creating a line up of people waiting to get in.
 - There are overhead doors and a loading dock that provide access to an enclosed area behind the halls for loading/unloading. NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE INTO THE HALLS.
 - NOTE ALL the overhead doors will remain closed until the show is FINISHED on Sunday this includes

- Parking (see map)
 - Once you unload/load you can park in the South Lot (recommended) or the North Lot. The show is being held in Halls C & D which are closest to the South Lot.
 - o RV parking will be available at no cost in the south lot parking area.
- Benching
 - o All reserved benching will be pre-assigned, and no changes will be made. People wishing to bench together will need to have identified this when reserving.
 - Unreserved benching ONLY in Designated Unreserved Benching area.
 - Dogs may be left in the building overnight, so long as they are in a crate and owners/handlers leave a phone number where they can be reached in case of emergency – on EVERY crate. . ANY EXHIBITOR WHO FAILS TO PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION MAY BE EXCUSED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE WEEKEND.
 - Any dogs left in the building overnight are left at the Owner/Handlers Risk.

Rules and Regulations

The club will be following any Public health Rules and Recommendations. These MUST be followed by all exhibitors, and they may be subject to change should the Venue, City of Lethbridge, Provincial or Federal Covid-19 Restrictions change.

With the increase in Covid cases as we move inside for winter events, please be kind to your fellow exhibitors and stay home if you are unwell.

PLEASE NOTE: ANYONE NOT CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOG IMMEDIATELY (THIS INCLUDES INDOOR EXERCISE PENS) WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE SHOWS FOR THE DURATION OF THE WEEKEND. YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED!!

GENERAL INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

ATTENTION: building opening/closing times - open 6 am sharp, and close at 11pm on Thursday and 10pm on Friday and Saturday sharp

- 1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience/Rally Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY EMAIL after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
- 5. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 6. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- 7. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
- 8. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 9. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be the halls C and D of Agri-food & Trade Halls, Exhibition Park.
- 10. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 11. No Pinch Collars allowed in the show precincts.

Dogs may be left in the building overnight, so long as they are in a crate and owners/handlers leave a phone number where they can be reached in case of emergency – on EVERY crate. ANY EXHIBITOR WHO FAILS TO PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION MAY BE EXCUSED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE WEEKEND. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE. You MUST have reserved benching to leave your dog overnight.

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES - BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

12.2.1 Regular official classes at a CKC conformation show shall be as described in (a) to (k) of this section. All classes must be divided by sex (except for Specials Only). Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs 9 months of age and under twelve (12) months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 MONTH - for dogs over 12 months of age but under 18 months of age.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

UNOFFICIAL/NON-REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED

BABY PUPPY Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

VETERAN In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran, Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group, Best Veteran in Show. A Veteran awarded Best

Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

RESERVE BEST IN SHOW: will be selected from the remaining 6 Breeds competing for BIS.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED:

Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Open HA, Open HB, Open 18A, Open 18B, Utility A, Utility B, Pre -Novice, Exhibition Only

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED:

Novice A & Novice B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Masters, Exhibition Only

See OBEDIENCE & RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS for complete information on classes. Rally/Obedience Ring Size – 60' x 50'

<u>CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (CCN)</u> A CCN allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility, Obedience & Rally O.

<u>To enter any trial, the dog MUST have a CCNumber prior to entering the event.</u> A dog in this category may not be entered as "TCN". The application form for the CCN can be found on the CKC website, under Forms On-Line, Registration. For more information and to register go to this link: http://www.ckc.ca/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Supplies/Canine-Companion

To be eligible to compete in these Obedience or Rally Obedience trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered, or debarked.

CHAPTER 4 – JUDGES

SECTION 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CKC Non-Participation Fee:

Entries sent by <u>Courier must be sent prepaid</u>, no <u>signature required</u>; To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial. The Lethbridge and District Kennel Club will refund entry, recording and listing fees if the above conditions are met. No Refunds will be given for the service fees provided by the dogshow.ca

A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least

ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
