

#### <u>Directions to</u> The Red Barn Event Centre:

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27.(aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From CR 27 South: Follow CR 27 northbound through Thorton. Continue north. After 5 minutes, look for signs on your right that show you have to turn LEFT to stay on CR 27. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

General	
Information	r

The Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of the agility building. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within the building. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted any where at the trial venue. Dogs must be ON LEASH at all times when outside the ring, in the building as well as on the trial grounds.

#### Event Information

Ring Surface is Top Dog rubber agility flooring with underlay. Handlers in all classes will be able to walk their course, without their dog prior to the start of the class.

Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent.

#### Obstacles

Obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization. Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1. 2010.

#### Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 mos. of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN)

#### Bitches in Season & Refunds

Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season may not compete. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except as noted in this premium list. The ONLY exception is bitches in season. Unfortunately we can not refund any entries, after closing for injured dogs or any other reason. Anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date will receive a credit in the amount of 50% of their entry fees towards a future PDC CKC trial held within twelve (12) months of this trial (excludes online entry service charge if applicable).

#### Trophies

Rosettes/ribbons will be given for 1st to 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights. \*\*\*NEW\*\*\*To prevent an increase in entry fees, New Title Rosettes will be available at a cost of \$5.00. Tabs with the title name are still no charge.

#### Are you in the correct Class?

**Selected Class:** Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class but can not be entered in the Selected Class and Regular Class at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Selected Class must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice level. Dogs will jump one jump height lower then its Regular jump height and get 10% more time then the Regular Standard course time. For full rules on the Selected Class please refer to the Official CKC Agility rule book.

**Novice A** is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.

**Novice B** is for agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

**Excellent A** is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

**Excellent B** is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Excellent B in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in. A dog only needs to be entered in Excellent B for the class that he/she has achieved the excellent title in. ie. A dog can be in Excellent A JWW and Excellent B Standard.

**Veteran Class:** a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one jump height lower then its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time then the Regular Standard course time. For full rules on these classes please refer to the Official CKC Agility rule & regulations.
