Please add an administrative fee of \$5.00 to the total of entry fees submitted.

Entries close at 8:00 p.m., Friday, September 28, 2018, or when entry limit is reached, whichever occurs earlier.

LIMITED ENTRY

Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour less time for walk-throughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. On Sunday October 16, 2016, each obedience trial will be limited to 4 hours of judging, and each rally obedience trial will be limited to 3 hours of judging. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

MIXED AND UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS

These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC approved microchip. Mixed breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

Held under CKC Rules. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the trial on that day. The Caledon Kennel Association will be offering a rosette and prize (donated by Denise Langley) for the Best Overall Junior Handler.

Junior Handling Numbers: Effective January 1, 2016 – Section 3.4.1 "All Junior Handlers with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked"

BEFORE YOU ENTER A RALLY "A" CLASS!

If the dog you are entering has earned any CKC obedience title other than a PCD (e.g., CD, CDX, OTCH), the dog <u>CANNOT</u> be entered in any Rally "A" class.

Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC CDX title CANNOT enter the "A" classes.

Entering the wrong class will result in the cancellation of legs and titles.

U.S.A. EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry, will be accepted.

Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured.

Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Telephone/fax entries are accepted by The Entry Line at 1-800-293-2935; (fax) 519-754-0796.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 5. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 6. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 7. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 8. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2018 AT 8:00 pm, OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 9. Identification cards and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Trial Secretary upon arrival at the trial.
- 10. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Caledon Kennel Association will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be the entire building of Campaign Dog Academy.

NEW – CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- 1. A non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- 2. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- 3. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- 4. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMPAIGN DOG ACADEMY

From Hwy. 401 (Eastbound or Westbound):

Take Trafalgar Rd. (Exit 328) north to Hwy. 7

Turn left at Hwy. 7

Turn right at first set of stoplights (22nd Side Road). Gas station with Tim Horton's is on the northeast corner.

Campaign Dog Academy is on the left (north) side with "horse stable" wood fences.
