

Awards and Prizes:

Ribbons for qualifying dogs will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height in each Class.
 All dogs with a qualifying score will receive a qualifying ribbon.

CONDUCT: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups will be permitted between trials. A dog earning a title after the closing date may advance to a higher level providing the Trial Secretary is notified by AUGUST 5, 2016.

JUMP HEIGHTS:

8" for dogs 10" and under at the withers
 12" for dogs over 10" up to and including 14" at the withers
 16" for dogs over 14" up to and including 18" at the withers
 20" for dogs over 18" up to and including 22" at the withers
 24" for dogs over 22" at the withers

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

PLEASE NOTE: Trial dates for 2017 – August 18, 19, 20

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and 10 feet surrounding.
- Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials
- The trials will be held outside on a grass surface. The courses will be set up within an enclosure of 110' by 110'
- No provisions have been made for rain or sun - bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog.
- Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, then clean up.
- Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm-up area and on the course.
- No food or other device will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well-fitted plain buckle collar, quick release collar or no collar on the course (note: no tags or decorations are permitted on the collar).
- The competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release on the entry form must be signed.
- All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- The Flat-coated Retriever Society of Canada reserves the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.
- There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs.
- Electronic timing will not be used

New CKC Agility Rule changes:

- ❖ A dog entered in Selected division may not move into Regular division at a later date. Dogs can no longer run two divisions.
- ❖ Lateral movement from Regular to Selected divisions.
- ❖ PAD – new game. This strategic game involves a point gathering component and a distance element.
- ❖ STEEPLECHASE – This fast paced new game is designed to test the dog's ability to negotiate a jumpers style course while performing the A-frame and weave poles.
- ❖ Some Class Standard Course Times have changed in order to provide more time for some jump heights and levels
- ❖ A and B levels have been eliminated in both Novice and Excellent levels. The highest level is now called Master Excellent
- ❖ Positionless table performance with a continual table count
- ❖ Weave poles in all Novice Classes
- ❖ One bar jumps can be used at any level
- ❖ A frame at 5 feet for dogs jumping 12" or less.
- ❖ Amendments were made to the Agility Rules & Regulations such that mixed or unrecognized breed dogs are allowed to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience, and Rally Obedience Trials effective July 1, 2014.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors:

Please note that fees are due and payable as listed above. Discounted cheques will not be accepted. Cheques in US funds are accepted for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". Bank drafts and money orders in Canadian funds are recommended.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

As of January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

Foreign born dogs require an ERN to earn CKC titles. This ERN MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event WILL result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. To obtain an ERN, send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN. With the above, include a cheque, money order or MC/VISA number to the Canadian Kennel Club. Visit www.ckc.ca for current rates.

Performance Event Number (PEN)

A PEN allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met: dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC, dog for some reason is not eligible for CKC registration, dog must be spayed or neutered, dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (not necessary for ILP dogs), dog cannot be on the CKC miscellaneous class list, and in the case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP number. A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a listed dog. Events may only be entered after PEN has been issued.
