Awards: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to teams achieving qualifying rounds. Rosettes will be awarded for new titles.

Move ups: will be permitted between classes if time permits.

FEO: Teams may enter any class as FEO. You must have a Novice Title to run off leash.

Entry Fees: \$20 per regular run, \$15 for FEO

Rules: This event adheres to CARO rules and regulations. CARO is open to all breeds of dogs and mixed breeds. Dogs must be at least six (6) months of age. Bitches in season, dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause pain or discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans may not participate. All dogs must wear a flat buckle or snap collar when entering the ring. One dog per registration form. The run fee total and payment arrangements will be emailed with your registration confirmation.

Shoes: *The rally course is set on rubber flooring, so no outside shoes allowed. Course can be run with inside shoes, slippers, socks or bare feet.*

Crating: There is no indoor crating. Be prepared to crate in your car. Limited shade tents may be available.

COVID Safety: Masks are mandatory within the building (“the Bunker) except while running the course. Outside, masks are optional and everyone is expected to maintain a distance that is respectful of the wishes of other participants and volunteers. Should PHO orders change before the trial, competitors will be notified of any increased safety guidelines.
