In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association and associated Specialty Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

- 1. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building.
- 2. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.

11. RV's will not be allowed to travel on the show grounds when judging is occurring. Under special circumstances (in case of emergency) the show superintendent will stop the show and parking personnel will assist in the safe removal of vehicle.

In 2012 I judged the BTCA Champagne Regional Specialty in Decatur, Illinois and the Bull Terrier Club of Wales BT Open Show in Cardiff, Wales. In 2013 my focus was to obtain my Canadian Terrier Group accreditation. I traveled from coast to coast judging four major all-breed championship shows in that regard. I was honoured to be selected to the Panel of Judges for the 2013 CKC Show of Shows event in Ottawa. In 2014 I judged three BTCA BT Specialties (ROM events) at Texas Gulf Coast (Houston), Canfield in Ohio and Decater in Alabama. In all of these events I also judged part of the Terrier Group. In April 2015 I judged a BT and MBT ROM Specialty in Sydney, NSW, Australia and have been accredited by the ANKC.

I served the Bull Terrier Fanciers Association in Canada for over ten years in many executive committee positions including Show Chair of the Bronze Trophy Show. In the Niagara area, I am a member of both the Seaway Kennel Club and the St. Catharines Kennel Club. Internationally, I can usually be found at the Trophy Shows in Coventry, UK and the Dutch International Championships in Lieden, NL each year.

DR. STEVEN L. KEATING, Ph.D – is an independent Human Resource and Medical Care Consultant in Dallas, Texas. He has over 40 years of experience as an administrator and Human Resource Specialist with expertise in customer-focused satisfaction, employee relations, organization design and development, risk management, medical-vocational case management, employee assistance, and training and development initiatives. In addition, he is a retired adjunct professor of business and management classes at the university level in Dallas, TX.

Dr. Steve Keating (SUTTON PLACE PEKINGESE) has been involved in dogs his entire life and in the Pekingese breed for over forty years. Over the years, Steve has been very fortunate to enjoy many successes in his life. One success, which he has mutually shared with his life partner Don Sutton, included breeding and owning one of the most wonderful breed of dogs – the Pekingese. Over the years, while actively breeding through 1992 they had the privilege of owning and handling to title 36 Pekingese champions, of which 24 of those were OWNER, BREEDER and HANDLED to title. Of great special joy and happiness has been the thrill and honor of owning and handling English, American, and International Champion – Rosayleen "The Gaffer" at Sun Salve, bred by Mrs. Eileen Newman and handled in England to 14 Championship Certificates by Mr. Terry Nethercott of Sun-Salve fame of London, England.

As an American Kennel Club (AKC) judge, Dr. Keating is currently approved for five plus groups – the Sporting Group, Working Group, Toy Group, Non-Sporting Group, Herding Group, four Hound breeds and several Terrier breeds as well as Junior Showmanship and Best-In-Show.

Over hias career Stryder earned #1 GSD in obedience in Canada in both 2008 and 2009, was GSDCC Inc. National Specialty Obedience Victor both those years and in 2009 also earned #7 on the top 10

She is also the breeder-owner-handler of Dachshunds under the "Von Der Hall II" prefix.

Frances is a Lecturer in charge of Breeders and new Judges training in Cynology and FCI Groups for the FAC-Argentina, KCU-Uruguay, ACCC-Columbia, KCB –Bolivia/Cochabamba, KCC-Chile and is a recognized breed specialist for Yorkshire Terriers, Dogo Argentino, Old English Sheepdogs, Chihuahuas, Dalmatians, Siberian Huskies, Kuvaszok, Great Danes, Giant, Standard and Miniature Schnauzers, Maltese, Shih Tzu, Afghans, Smooth and Wire Fox Terriers, all Dachshunds, American Cocker Spaniels, German Shorthaired Pointers and all Poodles. Keoli's Small Kraft Warning to 1st in the Toy Group at the AKC Centennial show in 1984 and in 1987 she was Kennel Review's top female Professional Handler.

Mrs. Stacy judged the 2013 Pomeranian National Specialty and has judged major shows throughout the U.S including Westminster and AKC Eukanuba. In addition she has enjoyed assignments in Japan, Argentina, Mexico, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Thailand and Taiwan.

Mrs. Stacy has been a member of the American Pomeranian Club for better than 30 years and has served on their board as a Director, Treasurer and Standard revision committee member and judges mentor. She has been a member of the American Maltese Association for more than 25 years and judged their 2008 National Specialty. Mrs. Stacy is approved to judge all Toy, Non-Sporting, Herding, Hound breeds, all Terrier breeds, American Cockers, English Cockers, English springers, English Setters, Labrador Retrievers, Golden Retrievers, Miscellaneous, Junior Showmanship and Best in Show.

CONFORMATION

The following CKC conformation classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

<u>Junior Puppy:</u> for dogs 6 mths of age but under 9 mths of age. <u>Senior Puppy:</u> for dogs 9 mths of age but under 12 mths of age <u>12-18 Months:</u> for dogs 12 mths of age and under 18 mths of age

Canadian Bred: for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded. Bred by Exhibitor: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open: for all dogs.

<u>Specials Only:</u> dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class. <u>Exhibition Only:</u> for all dogs over 6 mths of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class).

Veterans: offered Saturday, Sunday only. Veterans will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each.

The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Veteran in Group and Best Veteran in Show. Dogs must be 7 years or older on the day of the show.

<u>Baby Puppy (3-6 Mths): offered Friday, Saturday, Sunday only.</u> For dogs 3 mths of age & under 6 mths of age – dogs will compete in this unofficial class for Best Male/Best Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Group & Show. They do not compete for Winners.

OBEDIENCE

Pre-Novice: for any pure bred dog that has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in

Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A dog may be entered in this class that has not earned the title of CD in Canada or US.

Novice A: for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for this class.

Novice B: for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class.

Novice C: for any purebred dog that has gained a CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced title and exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice classes. Scores earned in Novice C are not eligible for High in Trial. This is an elective class and offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience. Dogs may be entered in Novice C class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial classes.

Novice Intermediate: For any dog that has earned a CD or higher obedience title. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are NOT eligible for High in Trial.

Open A: for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Open B: for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. A dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog eligible for UD is also eligible for entry in this class at the same trial.

<u>UtilityA:</u> for any purebred dog that has won the title of CDX in CANADA. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'group examination' exercise.

<u>Utility B:</u> for any purebred dog and handler where the dog has achieved a CDEX and a UD title and for dogs and handlers where the handler has put a MOTCH title on any dog.

RALLY

<u>Rally Novice A:</u> Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

<u>Rally Novice B:</u> Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. No dog may be entered in Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Intermediate: For dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RI or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. Dog handled by owner or any other person.

Rally Advanced A: For dogs that have won the Rally Novice title but have not won the Rally Advanced title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

<u>Rally Advanced B</u>: for dogs that have won the Rally Novice title. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

Rally Excellent A: for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced title but have not won the Rally Excellent title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.
