### JUVENILE / VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in both Sweepstakes. The club will retain 10% of total entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be distributed as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> in each class – 35% of entry fees for that class and a rosette
- 2<sup>nd</sup> in each class – 25% of entry fees for that class and a rosette

### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female:

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

### NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

| STRIP DOWN             | Shall be offered for any CKC registered American Cocker Spaniel of any age over 6 months (including neutered or spayed dogs). Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum length of 1 ½ inches long on any portion of the body, with the exception of the ears where no length restrictions apply. Entrants are to be judged on conformation. All males will be judged first as one class, and then all bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of these two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Down. Entrants must be entered in a Regular Class in the Specialty, Obedience Trial or Agility, or Exhibition Only to compete in the Stripped Down. |
| PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS | For CKC registered American Cocker Spaniels who have received any title (conformation, obedience, agility, and field) in their respective country of ownership. #### **ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER**

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act* but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration form and ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca> To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN form with a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.**

#### **ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee**

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

#### **WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES**

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show

1. Dog Show Rulebooks are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the NACA premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7

**Section 15.1.12**

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
