All fees include HST and are in Canadian funds. A TCN fee is payable for all dogs entered at trials who do not have an individual CKC registration number, an ERN or a PEN. Entries may be submitted by email, with payment by e-transfer freekashpeng@sympatico.ca. Use password WCECtrial. Entries close at 4:00 p.m., Wednesday March 21, 2023, or when entry limit is reached, whichever occurs earlier.

LIMITED ENTRY

Entry in the obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. Total time allotted for judging will be 3 hours. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 4. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 5. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 6. All dogs shown in a Non-Regular or Unofficial class must be entered in one of the Official classes, or for "Exhibition Only"
- 7. Dogs entered "For Exhibition only" and otherwise entered only in Non-regular or Unofficial classes may be spayed or neutered
- 8. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 9. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE **Tuesday, March 21, 2023 at 4 pm**, OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 10. Armband numbers and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close.
- 11. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Chair will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Whippet Club of Eastern Canada (WCEC) will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. A dog shall not be touched without permission of the owner or agent.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be the training hall at the North Gower Dog Ranch.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
