

Judging Schedule

***Important Note – All Exhibitors

- All times are approximate. Please arrive a minimum of 60 minutes before your classes scheduled start time.
- Only those entered in the class that is being judged will be allowed in the building.
- There will be a sign on the door indicating what class(es) are currently being judged. If your class is not posted on the door, **do not enter**.
- Following SHA guidelines, masks are required at all times, in the building, including in the ring.
- While in the building please follow provincial protocols regarding physical distancing. The building will be set up in such a way to make this as easy as possible.
- The heeling patterns, sit of down stay for pre-novice, order of exercises for Open HB, Open 18B and Utility B, change of position pattern for Open 18B and the type of articles for Utility will be posted outside the building a minimum of 30 minutes before those classes.
- There is no indoor benching, however you may bring a crate in with you during your class and take it out with you when you leave.
- Your arm band number will be assigned to you by Dogshow.ca. Arm bands will be on a separate table from the trial secretary for you to pick up.
- If you need to approach the trial secretary (questions about your entry etc.), please ensure you keep an appropriate distance.
- Qualifying score will be announced by the judge but there will be no ribbon presentation inside the ring. Ribbons and score sheets will be on a separate table for exhibitors to pick up.
- You are expected to clean up after your dog. Ex'ing your dog may be done at the east end of the building only.

WITHDRAWLS/ABSENT

- If you need to withdraw, due to Bitch in Season, COVID, or know you will be absent, for any other reason, please let us know as soon as possible. Thank you.

***Important Note – Pre-Novice Class

- Figure 8 “posts” will be pylons which may be in the ring for the duration of your run.
- Only teams who have qualified the individual exercises will be invited to participate in the group exercise.

***Important Note – Novice A/B classes

- Enter the ring on leash
- Figure 8 “posts” will be pylons which may be in the ring for the duration of your run.
- After the Figure 8 you will be instructed to remove your leash and place it on the chair inside the ring, near the entrance. You may leave your dog on a stay or take your dog with you. In this class you may gently guide your dog by the collar if needed.

- Upon completion of the recall exercise you may leave your dog on a stay or take your dog with you to get your leash. **Your dog must be under control and be on leash before leaving the ring.**
- Only teams who have qualified the individual exercises will be invited to participate in the group exercises.

*****Important Note – Open HA/HB/18A/18B classes**

- Enter the ring on leash and place your leash and dumbbell on the chair inside the ring, near the entrance
- Figure 8 “posts” will be pylons which may be in the ring for the duration of your run.
- Before the retrieve exercises you will be instructed to get your dumbbell from the chair. You may leave your dog on a stay or take them with you but they must remain under control.
- Upon the completion of the retrieve exercises you will place your dumbbell back on the chair. You may leave your dog on a stay or take them with you but they must remain under control.
- Upon completion of your round you may leave your dog on a stay or take your dog with you to get your leash. **Your dog must be under control and be on leash before leaving the ring.**
- Only teams who have qualified the individual exercises will be invited to participate in the group exercises.

*****Important Note – Utility A & B classes**

- Enter the ring on leash and place your leash, articles and glove (if seek back is the first exercise you may take it with you to the start of the exercise) on the chair inside the ring, near the entrance
- The ring steward will use disposable gloves and/or tongs to handle the scent articles. The articles to be scented will be placed on a table for the handler to retrieve before scenting. When the handler has scented the article they will place it on a clip board that is on the table for the judge to use to place the article in the pile.
- Before the seek back exercise (unless it is the first exercise) you will be instructed to get your glove from the chair. You may leave your dog on a stay or take them with you but they must remain under control. Upon the completion of the exercise you will place your glove back on the chair. You may leave your dog on a stay or take them with you but they must remain under control.
- Upon completion of your round you may leave your dog on a stay or take your dog with you to get your leash. **Your dog must be under control and be on leash before leaving the ring.**
