We are pleased to offer a Prize and/or Rosette to the following winners: First place in each class. All qualifying scores will receive a ribbon.

RALLY OBEDIENCE OFFICIAL CLASSES:

NOVICE A: Available to any dog that has not earned a RN or CD title. Handler must be owner, co-owner or close family member. Handler who has handled a dog to a CDX, or who has instructed dog training classes is not eligible. A handler may enter more than one dog in this class.

NOVICE B: Available to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score in Rally Advanced. A handler may enter more than one dog in this class.

ADVANCED A: Available to any dog with a RN, but not a RA, or a CD. Handler must be owner, co-owner or close family member. Handler who has handled a dog to a CDX, or who has instructed dog training classes is not eligible. A handler may enter more than one dog in this class.

ADVANCED B: Available to any dog that has earned a RN. A handler may enter more than one dog in this class.

EXCELLENT A: Available to any dog with a RA, but not a RE, or a CD. Handler must be owner, co-owner or close family member. Handler who has handled a dog to a CDX, or who has instructed dog training classes is not eligible. A handler may enter more than one dog in this class.

EXCELLENT B: Available to any dog that has earned a RN. A handler may enter more than one dog in this class.

GENERAL RULES

1. The Trial Superintendent will have full control of the Trial, which shall be governed by CKC rules.
2. A judge officiating at a trial held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
3. Any dog excused by the Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the trial.
4. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs & Exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to dog or exhibitor regardless of cause.
5. It is expected that anyone participating in this trial will be familiar with the CKC rules pertaining to such an event. If you have any questions, CKC Obedience and Rally Obedience Trial Rule Books will be available for viewing at the Trial Secretary's table.
6. Entries will be acknowledged by mail as soon as possible after the closing date.
7. All dogs are to be exercised only in designated areas. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the trial.
8. All dogs must be kept under control at all times.
9. Entry fees will be refunded if a bitch comes in season after entry of the bitch has been submitted. A veterinarian's certificate certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 days preceding the Trial must be delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
10. Trial Precincts are defined as Northmount Community League and skating rinks.

DAY OF ENTRY* - new rule of CKC. An entry will be accepted on day of entry 1 hour prior to beginning of first class of trial. Entry will not be accepted if the trial entered is at full numbers (4 hours of judging)

Please note all day of entry must be on Approved entry forms (some will be provided at the show secretaries table) and only accepted if paid in cash or money order. personal cheques or credit card payments can be accepted at the show.
