7. In the case of a tie, the tie breaker shall be the highest score: **first** in Field, **then** in Obedience, **then** in Rally Obedience and, **finally**, in Agility. .
8. The individual responsible for determining the winner of the Versatility Award must be a member of the Irish Setter Club of Canada or his or her appointee. If the ISCC member responsible for organizing the Award wishes to enter or handle a dog in the competition, **a different individual must be selected** to calculate the relevant scores. Note that points toward the Versatility Title have no official standing with the Canadian Kennel Club and are strictly an ISCC award recognizing versatile Irish Setters and their owners.

If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Obedience Award

The IRISH SETTER CLUB OF CANADA is pleased to award a prize to the Irish Setter achieving the highest qualifying score in each Alberta Kennel Club all-breed obedience trial.

VERSATILITY AWARD 2012

The purpose of the Versatility Award is to encourage owners and breeders to develop their Irish in performance activities and, in particular, in hunting, obedience and agility. The Award is given to the Irish Setter who accumulates the highest number of points based on performance in two or more events held in conjunction with the Irish Setter Club of Canada Specialty.

The winner will receive a trophy and rosette in recognition of the achievement. The Award will be given at the end of the Field Test if there is an Irish competing in that discipline. Otherwise, the winner will be notified and the trophy and rosette sent to them, and announced on the Club website and in the Newsletter.

GENERAL RULES

1. A dog must compete in at least two of five disciplines (conformation, hunting, obedience, rally obedience and/or agility).
2. Qualifying scores must be earned in the Specialty Field Test, Obedience, Rally Obedience, and/or Agility to be counted.
3. For the 2011 ISCC Specialty, arrangements have been made for Irish Setter competitors in Obedience, Rally Obedience and/or Agility to be included in the Host Show's scheduled trials that take place on Saturday and Sunday. Scores for versatility in these disciplines may be accumulated on either day. Those competing in *Field* must do so on Tuesday, August 7 at the official ISCC Specialty Field Test which is being held jointly with the German Short-Haired Pointer Club of Canada (GSPCC). Field Test premium lists are available on the ISCC website or from the **Field Test Secretary (Manette Jones - phone: 403-648-2577 or email: manette@shaw.ca).** Field entries close on **Wednesday, August 1, 2012 – 8:00 p.m. MDT**
3. Eligibility to enter a particular class is controlled by CKC rules and regulations for each discipline; for example:
 - Once a dog receives a title in a particular field class *and* has received official CKC confirmation of the title, he/she may only be entered in the next higher class (e.g., an FDJ-titled dog must enter the field test at the FD level).
 - A dog that has completed a CD title *and* has received official CKC confirmation of the title must move up to the CDX or Utility level; a dog competing in Utility may continue to compete in the CDX class.
 - An altered dog may only enter conformation in the Veteran classes (regular class and Sweepstakes), the Field Dog class or the altered classes where available. See premium list for additional requirements when entering these classes.
5. Only the highest possible points will be counted per discipline. For example, a dog awarded both Best in Specialty (20 points) and Best Puppy (15 points) would receive a maximum of 20 points, not 35 points (see point structure, attached). Similarly, a dog awarded both Highest Qualifying Overall Score in Obedience for the Specialty (20 points) *and* Highest Qualifying Score in an Obedience Class (12 points) would receive 20 points, not 32. However, a Best in Specialty who also wins Best in Field Test would receive a total score of 40 (two different disciplines).
6. Because CKC rules do not allow FDX-titled dogs to continue to enter field tests, a dog that has completed FDX will be granted 5 points *only if* he or she enters in another discipline (conformation, obedience, agility and/or rally). Similarly, a Canadian Special in conformation will be given 5 points if entered into another discipline.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

BABY PUPPY	dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points.
JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades</u>

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.
FIELD DOG	For all dogs who have earned a Certificate of Merit or better in an official class at a Licensed Field Trial or Field Dog test in Canada or the United States or who have received a FTCH, FD, FDJ or FDX under the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club by the close of entries. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

Attention All Foreign Exhibitors

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7
5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.
