Dog Judging Bio:

Deborah Graffmann

I grew up in Quebec, Canada, surrounded by animals. My family had German Shepherds, an Irish Terrier, and a Pomeranian. In the early 1970's I began showing and breeding Irish Setters; my handlers were also showing Whippets and I was able to obtain my first one from them: MaGriffe's Winged Foot Whipper, who did nice winning in the group ring.

I migrated from the Irish Setters to the Whippets and registered "Vantage" as a Whippet kennel in 1980. Vantage produced many champions including Specialty winners and is behind many winning lines today.

My husband Gordon wanted a Boxer so we acquired our first one in 1991. We were the first people to import from Argentina following that country's recognition by the CKC. We imported from the world famous Willsam kennels. We actively bred and showed many Boxers to Championships and breed standings.

Although we no longer breed we still show and have the number one Basset Hound in Canada for 2012. We recently imported a Basset Hound from a top producing kennel in Brazil.

I am the President of the Kilbride & District Kennel Club in Ontario. I became an all-breed judge in 2009 and have judged internationally as well as in Canada.

In my professional life I am the President of a management consulting company.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

BABY PUPPY - 3 months & under 6 months on the day of the show

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12 - 18 MONTH 12 months & under 18 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED – Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs. **Split by color Fawn/Brindle**

VETERANS - open to all dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veterans Male & Female classes will not compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veteran dogs may be neutered or spayed.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. Should a dog entered for Specials Only place in its group at the show then all awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

AWARD OF MERIT This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. One Award of Merit is offered at the discretion of the judge for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

STUD DOG & GET - The name of the Stud Dog must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the dog and two of his progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY - The name of the Bitch must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the bitch and two of her progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

BRACE CLASS.... This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female: Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder. NEW: A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: “have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level.”

Juvenile:

Classes (Sexes divided) 3 – 6 months, 6 - 9 months, 9 -12 months, 12-18 months.

Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best in Sweep 25% of entry fees
1st in each class 5% of entry fees
2n in each class Flat ribbon
3rd in each class Flat ribbon
4th in each class Flat ribbon
(The balance of all Sweepstakes money received is retained for administration purposes in each sweepstakes.)

Veterans:

Classes (Sexes divided) 7-9 Years 9+ Years

Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best in Sweep 25% of entry fees
1st in each class 5% of entry fees
2n in each class Flat ribbon
3rd in each class Flat ribbon
4th in each class Flat ribbon
(The balance of all Sweepstakes money received is retained for administration purposes in each sweepstakes.)

Junior Handling

This competition will be offered on Saturday during the lunch break. There will be a \$2.00 fee which will be collected at the show. Any dog entered in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or for exhibition only in the show that day. The dog need not be owned by the Jr. Handler or any of his immediate family.

CLASSES

Pee Wees From ages 4-6 some may be 7 during the competition year depending on when their birthday falls.

Junior Novice From ages 7 until 10 years of age. Child must be 7 yrs old as of December 31, 2005 in order to start at Jr Novice. This is for children who have NOT won six firsts with competition.

Junior Open From ages 7-10 with same age restrictions as above. This class is for children who HAVE won six firsts with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class From ages 11 until 14 years of age who have NOT won six firsts with competition.

Intermediate Open Class From ages 11-14 years who HAVE won six firsts in the same class with competition.

Senior Novice Ages 15-18 years who have NOT won six first placements in the same class with competition.

Senior Open Ages 15-18 years who HAVE won six first placements in the same class.

This class is for handlers 15 yrs of age as of Dec 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors patrons, or equipment.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under C.K.C. rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. The ring shall not be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied with a fee set by CKC which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring.
10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from completion by action of the Show Committee.
