CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder:

SECTION 2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed excused or ordered from the ring bythe judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points. The new sytem proves for addional points for a dog awarded WINNERS also places in the GROUP as listed below:

A class dog awarded BEST IN SHOW at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five** (5) points at a **single show**.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number and (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level (15.1.13)

<u>Best Puppy in Breed</u>—Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed is <u>NOT</u> required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or has an ERN number at the time of closing of the entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championhip is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing that the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing at least one (1)hour prior to the BREED JUDGING at the show by the owner or handler.

Effective January, 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to SPECIALS if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and dog has been entered in the classes as a **LISTED** dog. Listing fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded**.

AN ERROR IN AN AGE SPECIFIED CLASS, DATE OF BIRTH, OR SEX, MAY BE AMENDED ON THE ENTRY FORM UP TO ONE HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE BREED IN QUESTION 8.2.5

DOG SHOW RULE 4.7.1

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Infringements of this rule are subject to disciplinary action.

DOG SHOW RULE 11.1 (UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT) it shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person during the running of, or in connection with an event, abuses or harasses a **Judge**,

Show Official, or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

<u>PRE NOVICE</u> is an elective class and shall be for any dog or any rec. or listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D.

<u>NOVICE A</u> shall be for any dog of any rec.,listed,mixed or unrecognized breed which hasn't earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all excercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner,co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B shall be for any dog of any rec.listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D.

NOVICE C shall be for any dog of any rec.listed, mixed or unrecognized breed that has earned the C.D. title or any higher Obedience titles.

<u>NOVICE INTERMEDIATE</u> is an elective class and shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles.

<u>OPEN HA or 18A</u> The open A class shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in these classes

<u>OPEN HB---</u>The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of CD. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any highter titles may enter in the Open B class A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional hadler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group excrecises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes.

<u>OPEN 18B</u> The requirements are the same as OPEN HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Poisitions Exercises. As described in the open HA and Open 18A classes.

<u>UTILITY A</u> shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H. may NOT handle in this class <u>UTILITY B</u> shall be for any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D.

<u>NOVICE A</u> dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally novice (R.N.) title or any CKC ObedienceTitle. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. No handler who has exhibited dogs through a CDX title or instructed on a regular basis will be eligible for the Novice A Class. No dog may be entered in Rally Novice A & B in any one trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

<u>NOVICE B</u> any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

<u>RALLY INTERMEDIATE</u> The Rally Intermediate class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Adanced Classes

<u>ADVANCED A</u> This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally R.A. title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. No Dog may be entered in the Rally Advanced A & B in any one trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. <u>ADVANCED B</u> this class will be for dogs that have won the Rally RN title. A dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

<u>EXCELLENT A</u> this class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA.) title but have not won the Rally R.E. title or any CKC Novice Obedience Title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner,or member of their immediate families. No dog may be entered in Rally Excellent A &B in any one trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. <u>EXCELLENT B</u> This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally RA title. A dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class <u>RALLY MASTER</u> This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E.title. A dog completing the R.M. Title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. <u>PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW:</u> INTERIOR OF THE BUILDING PLUS TWO FEET AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF THE BUILDING, AND TWO FEET AROUND THE OUTSIDE RING

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of these shows

2. The entry of a dog cannot be altered or cancelled afer entries close, except in the case of rule 8.2.5 (error in age, specified class, date of birth or sex).

3.Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made

4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

5. There will be a designated exercise areas. Dogs are not to be exercised nor vehicles parked except as stipulated.

This rule will be strictly enforced.

6.Smoking is not permitted in the building.

7.Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame or in season (except in the case of Obedience or Rally Obedience entries) or excused by the judge or veterinarian or barred from competition because it was incorrectly entered.

8.Obedience Exhibitors: any dog holding the American title in a particular class must enter the "B" class in Canada in that Obedience Class. Fees for a bitch in season will be refunded providing the owner/Agent produces a veterinarian's certificate TWO hours prior to judging.

9. The Fort GarryKennel Club will use diligence and care for the safety of all dogs exhibited but it cannot be responsible for the loss or damage of livestock, persons or property whether the result of accident or otherwise.

10.Dogs not entered in the shows will not be allowed on the premises except dogs entered for EXHIBITION ONLY

11.Dogs not required for further judging may be excused

12.If, because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Fort Garry Kennel Club it is impossible to open or complete the show(s) NO refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

DOG SHOW RULE 4.7.1

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Infringements of this rule are subject to disciplinary action.

DOG SHOW RULE 11.1 (UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT) It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person, during the running of, or in connection with an event, abuses or harasses a judge, show official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

CLASSIFICATIONS;

The following classes will be provided for, divided by sex: BABY PUPPY (4 mos. to under 6 mos.) JR. PUPPY 6 mos. to under 9 mos., SR. PUPPY 9 mos. to under 12 mos.;12-18 month class; CANADIAN BRED—for dogs born in Canada (Champions of any country excluded) BRED BY EXHIBITOR for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the BREEDER/CO-BREEDER; OPEN for all dogs; SPECIALS ONLY; For Canadian Champions EXHIBITION ONLY: for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for CKC registration.

BEST BREEDER OWNER-HANDLED DOG IN GROUP AND SHOW SUNDAY MAY 28, 2023

The handler of the dog must be the breeder and owner of record or a direct family member. The owner must show the dog at all levels of competition. This competition is open to non-professionals only. Anyone who has handled a dog for which they have received any compensation in any capacity in the past 3 years is not eligible to participate.

There are no additional fees for this event. Participants do not need to pre-register, but the dogs must be entered in a regular conformation class.

<u>TIME:</u> Following Puppy in Group and Puppy in Show

Breeder/Owner-Handled competition is an unofficial class. Patricipants do not need to pre-register, but will need to inform the ring steward following the breed judging that they are the breeder/owner. The handler of the dog must be the breeder/owner for the classes. Only Breeder/owner-handled dogs that receive a **BEST OF BREED** ribbon are elligible to compete in the Best Breeder/Owner Handled Dogs in Group. The winner of BOH in breed may compete in BOH in Group unless the dog was already defeated at the Best In Group level by another Breeder/Owner-Handled dog. The winner of BOH in Group will compete in BOH in Show after the completion of Best Puppy in Show unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best In Show level, by another Breeder/Owner-Handled dog that is entered in this competition.
