I CERTIFY that I am the registered owner(s) of the dog or that I am the authorized agent of the owner(s) whose name(s) I have entered above and accept full responsibility for all statements made in this entry. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry I (we) agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list. Also by signing this form, I certify that I will not hold the Show giving Club, its members, directors, employees or agents liable in the event of any accident of misfortune however caused.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. Entries close 8 P.M. (EST) Tuesday, November 9, 2021, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
- 6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Aurora & District Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
- 6. SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for breed conformation rings, and the facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers. Show Precincts end twelve (12) inches from the rings and do not include the grooming area of other areas of the facilities.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN).

TCNs can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or
- By contacting the Shows & Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252.

Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$62.40 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 4.7.3 states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Section 8.10 of the Conformation Show Rules & Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

NEW – MOVING BACK TO CLASSES

Section 8.10.5 A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.

- 2. SET-UP: After 2 p.m., Friday, November 19th, 2021.
- 3. The Hall will be open at 6 a.m. and will close at 10 p.m.
- 4. Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- 5. Photography and Videotaping: Still photography, videotaping, live streaming or filming will be conducted at the Aurora and District Kennel Club show. Your entry in, or attendance at, the Aurora and District Aurora and District Kennel Club show constitutes your permission and consent to the Aurora and District Kennel Club and its assignees and licensees to photograph, videotape, live stream or film, and to use the resulting photographic pictures, videotapes or films of yourself, your agents and/or your dogs for any purpose whatsoever and without payment or further release.
- 6. No photography or videotaping may be conducted for the purpose of resale within the show precincts by anyone other than the official Show Photographer without the express written consent from the Aurora and District Kennel Club.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

| Dogs competing* | 1 | 2 | 3 to 5 | 6 to 9 | 10 to 12 | 13 or more |
|------------------|---|---|--------|--------|----------|------------|
| Points allocated | 0 | 1 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 5 |

^{*}includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

 a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHEX POINTS

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

Section 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Section 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

ALTERED CHAMPION & ALTERED POINTS

Section 13.8.1 Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

Through the generosity of its members and friends, the Club VI Ontario will offer suitable prizes and / or rosettes, for the following awards: Best Overall, Best Junior and Best Senior Junior Handler.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex)

4 to 6 months, 6 to 9 months, 9 to 12 months, 12-15 Months and 15-18 Months

Veteran Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex) 7 to 9 years, 10 to 12 years and 13 years and over

Winners from each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

To enter Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes at this specialty.

To enter Veteran Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes or for Exhibition Only at this specialty.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows: Best in Sweepstakes will receive 25% of total entry fee. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 20% of total entry fee. First-place winners in each class will divide the remaining 30% of the total entry fee. 25% retained by the club for administration.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES BOTH SEXES

REGULAR CLASSES:

JUNIOR PUPPY – A dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

SENIOR PUPPY – A dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12-18 MONTHS – A dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

12-15 MONTHS – A dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

15-18 MONTHS – A dog between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.

CANADIAN BRED - A dog born in Canada.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – For all dogs.

FIELD CLASS – Dogs must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

VETERANS CLASS – For all dogs over 7 years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs compete for the regular placements, and the 1st-place dog and bitch will compete for Best of Breed. Veterans may be broken down into separate age categories. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

SEXUALLY ALTERED – Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age that have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

SPECIALS ONLY - Dogs that are Canadian Champions.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:

BABY PUPPY – A dog between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

STUD DOG & GET – Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BRACE – Two dogs shown by a single handler on one lead. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

TEAM – The requirements for this class are the same as those for the Brace Class except that four dogs shall be entered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

EXHIBITION ONLY – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in Regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular/Unofficial classes and/or Parades.

NATIONAL BREEDERS' CLASSIC RULES

BREEDER

- Enters a minimum of 3 dogs to a maximum of 5 dogs making up each Breeder's Team of the same breed.
- 2. Breeder must be the "breeder of record" on all dogs entered in the Team, but DOES NOT have to own the dog. (Co-breeders are permissible.)
- 3. Canadian Kennel Club as well as foreign registered dogs are eligible.
- 4. Spayed or neutered dogs are eligible.
- 5. Exhibits must be over 6 months of age.
- 6. Entry fee is \$38 per Team
- 7. Exhibits do not have to be entered in the regular Aurora & District Kennel Club shows.
- 8. Dogs can only be entered in one Team.

JUDGING

- The Royal Canin National Breeders' Classic will start MIDDAY on Saturday, November 20, 2021.
- 2. Teams will be divided into two units* (Group A and Group B) by a draw and posted Friday morning. Just prior to the start of judging, the judge for each unit will be drawn.
- 3. Each unit will be judged by one of the Royal Canin's selected judges.
- 4. Three Finalists will be selected from each unit to advance to the Finals to compete for Best in Classic and Reserve Best in Classic Awards.
- 5. Judges will judge the Teams as a unit to evaluate the overall quality of the breeding program as represented by the Team its consistency of breed type and soundness.

PLEASE NOTE: Judging for the Classic will be scheduled so entered Breeders' Teams will not be judged at the All Breed during the Breeders' Classic. Please ensure that you have sufficient handlers to show your team. Breeder of Record DOES NOT have to handle a dog. We will also bring the dogs in each unit into the ring in breed size order.

Prizes – Awarded to the Breeder of Record

Best in Classic - \$1,500 Reserve Best in Classic - \$500 Finalists (6* awarded) - \$100

*NOTE: If the entry exceeds 60 Teams, the entry will be divided into 3 units, with three finalists chosen from each Unit.

AURORA & DISTRICT KENNEL CLUB COVID-19 INFORMATION

The Aurora & District Kennel Club recognizes the impact and risks that COVID-19 continues to have on our community. It is important to ensure the safety of our club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges and exhibitors. The Aurora & District Kennel Club will follow all federal, provincial, municipal and facility protocols related to COVID-19. However, public-health guidelines, restrictions and show protocols may change between the posting of this Premium List and the publishing of the Judging Schedule.

By entering our show, you agree to abide by any guidelines or protocols that the Aurora & District Kennel Club has in place at the time the shows are hosted. If any club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges, or fellow exhibitors are subject to abusive language or behaviour, or if you fail to abide by the show protocols, this may result in your dismissal from the show with no right of entry-fee refund.

Anyone attending the show must provide proof of DOUBLE COVID-19 VACCINE & PICTURE ID upon arrival (provincial regulations). NO PROOF, NO ADMITTANCE TO THE SHOW.

Show Site & Rings

- There will be signs to indicate when you are entering the official show grounds. Entrance will have a screening station.
- Judges' tables, in-ring grooming tables and other 'touch surfaces' will be sanitized regularly.
- There will be separate entrances and exits for each ring.
- Exhibitors will pick up placement ribbons/prizes as they exit the ring. No recycling of ribbons.
- There will be an official show photographer, and he may have his own COVID-19 protocols.

Masks

- Masks are mandatory while in the ring and the show precincts. Masks must be worn completely, covering both mouth and nose.
- If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you at a cost (limited supply).
- Face shields, neck warmers, masks with exhalation valves, handkerchiefs and any other loose fitting face coverings are NOT masks.
- Anyone unable to wear a mask due to a medical condition will require a medical exception letter from an authorized health professional. You must be able to show the letter to the Show Secretary. In this case, the exhibitor would be required to wear a face shield.

Social Distancing

- Maintain at least 2 metres (6 feet) of social distancing while at the show venue. The Aurora &
 District Kennel Club is ensuring extra space is provided in the rings and surrounding area so
 that adequate space is available to socially distance.
- No hugging or handshaking permitted on any of the official grounds of the show.
- Wash hands and use hand sanitizer as frequently as possible.
- Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
- Stay in own set-up, except for ring time, washroom, photos, exercising dog breaks.

Refund Policy

- If the Aurora & District Kennel Club is required to cancel the show due to any federal, provincial, municipality or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, a full refund of all entry fees (less expenses) will be offered.
- All entry-service fees and credit-card fees are non-refundable.
- If you are unable to attend the dog show, for any reason, after entries have closed, refunds will not be provided.
- If you cannot travel to the show due to a government restriction on travel, refunds will not be provided.


